  - We are off to a great start.

- The safety of both students and staff is our number one priority and we are working hard to ensure safe practices are in place. We reviewed protocols with students at the start of the year, we make mention of protocols over announcements and teachers continue to review protocols with students regularly.

# 5. Junior High Athletics

Excited to have our kids back participating in sports and want to ensure that we do everything possible to ensure we can continue to do so throughout the year.

Junior High principals have made some decisions around junior high athletics, specifically Volleyball and Cross Country.

# Volleyball:

- 1) Continue with league games, schedule to be determined and sent out soon.
- Consistent masking. All athletes and coaches wear a mask when entering a school and when sitting on the bench, regardless of school rules for EIPS and EICS. Players do NOT have to wear masks when playing.
- 3) EIPS Jr. High Schools will not be participating in any tournaments for the month of September. As principals, we will revisit participation in tournaments in the next couple of weeks.
- 4) No spectators allowed. In order to limit potential spread of COVID-19 during EIPS athletic events, spectators are not permitted at practices and games at this time. We ask that when dropping off or picking up student athletes outside the school, parents and guardians maintain a 2-metre distance from other families.
- 5) We are trying to see if we can stream games for parents. Hope to share information on the Athletics website so check back on game day.
- 6) Team players are considered PLAYERS, not spectators. In the event that a school has two teams travel to a venue players will not be considered spectators and assigned to sit in an assigned area while the other team plays.
- 7) Refs and score keepers are NOT considered spectators.

#### Cross Country:

- 1) Mr. Bennet and Mr. Bachor are overseeing Cross Country
- 2) We will be continuing with our EIPS Cross Country Race date has been moved to October 5<sup>th</sup>.
- 3) We will not be running a Zone meet this year.

## 6. Leader in Me

- Cost has increased from \$1500 a year to \$5000 although they were willing to give us this year at \$2700
- Discussed with staff in August and September
- Staff provided input

- Staff completed a survey. Every single staff member that completed the survey, stated that we should discontinue Leader in Me.
- We agree with the 7 habits, but tough to get buy-in from K-9, cost has gone up and it would take a lot of time to train staff with the current version.
- PAS has always covered our membership fee and in prior year put money towards our program.
- Will be withdrawing from Leader In Me.

#### 7. Cash 4 Care

- Strathcona Food Bank will be our Charity of Choice this year.
- Staff and students can bring money to donate on Early Dismissal days.
