#### a. EIPS Board Trustee

- Some school tours completed (e.g., Uncas).
- French immersion public meeting held Feb. 7. No changes expected for at least a year.
- Approved \$5000 for School Council conference.

#### c. Administrative Report

- 1. **Parent/Teacher/Student Conferences** took place on February 15 and 16. Parents are encouraged to contact their child's teacher(s) if they did not book or were unable to do so. Our Book Fair was Feb. 13-17 and was a huge success once again.
- 2. **Kindergarten and Returning Student Registration has begun**. All current families should have received an email with the link and instructions (for returning student registration). Returning Student Registration closes Feb. 28. Students currently in Grades 7 and 8 had the chance to apply to the honours program. We did not have enough interest, and most people that applied, were not willing to leave LLR and attend a different school. We did have 2 students that were accepted into the Honours program and will attend a different school next year.
- 3. School Fees Planning for next year has begun.
  - In mid-December we sent out a message to all families regarding **school fees** for the upcoming year. The message included information about the 2022-23 school fees and let parents know that we would be discussing school fees at our January School Council meeting.
  - January School Council meeting School fees were discussed. Based on the conversations from our School Council meeting and parameters set by the Board, we have come up with our proposed changes. (See attached). Jeff reviewed the proposed fees for 2023-24.
  - o Jeff will send out another email to parents with the **proposed fees** as presented here. Parents will be invited to email the school with any questions. Since there is no School Council meeting in March, parents can ask call or email the school if they have any questions or can ask questions at our April 11 School Council meeting. We will be sending the proposed fees for Board approval March 17.
- 4. We need to keep in mind that we may have a **new curriculum for Grades 4-6** next year and as such some of the field trip currently being offered may need to change. In addition, the Board recognizes that, during the school year, flexibility is needed to make fee additions or changes for missed fees or new opportunities. These will be subject to approval by the Superintendent and Secretary-Treasurer in June with any approved changes.
- 5. **Pink Shirt Day** is Wednesday, February 22. Staff and students are encouraged to wear something pink to stand up against bullying.
- 6. **High School Musical** is fast approaching. Performances on March 14 17. Tickets are \$10 each and shows are 5:30pm and 7:30pm
- 7. **Alberta Education Surveys** Surveys were sent to parents with children in grade 4, 7 and 10. Students in these Grades complete surveys along with all teachers. The deadline has been extended from February 24 to March 17 to complete the online survey.

- 8. **EIPS Surveys** Once again, the Division is conducting its EIPS Annual Feedback Surveys from March 1-15. In total, there are three surveys, one for EIPS families, one for staff and one for students in Grade 9 and Grade 12. Collectively, the surveys gauge the Division's progress toward meeting the priorities, goals and outcomes outlined in the Division's <u>Four-Year Education Plan</u>, and help EIPS develop strategies to better serve students and the wider community. The surveys are voluntary, anonymous and take only a few minutes to complete. Again, Communication Services will send more information when the survey launches. We have included a mid-year review for LLR families. Here is a copy of it.
- 9. **Student Voice** I would like to introduce a format to encourage Student Voice. I will be meeting with each of the three divisions K-3, 4-6, and 7-9 separately to find out what they like at LLR, what they don't like and what ideas they have to make our school a better place. I have led School Councils at many different schools, but of course with COVID it was tough to gather in large groups. Now that we are on the other side of COVID, I think it a great time to introduce something like this. I am not sure if LLR has had this previously, but I do believe it very worthwhile. More information will follow.
- 10. **Grade 9 Farewell Date** is Friday, June 16. Junior High Awards is June 19 in the afternoon.
